- Moody's Ratings- and the increased rating and its positive effect on borrowings.
- Bonds went over last years rates versus this year

- Retirement-the expected cost in 2027 is going up substantially based off of the State's numbers. The wages being used look to be inflated but the actual percentage the municipalities and tax payers have are burden with are increasing by over 10%. Mayor is going to reach out to State reps and find out what is causing this.
- 160 Harry L Drive-Water penalty request to dismiss Modified Resolution 188, the amount was changed from \$50 to \$1,085.66.
- Olive Street Project - Mayor Meaney also discussed about the water issue on Olive St and that the Village was using Water Fund Balance to fix the problem.
