A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ADOPTION OF LOCAL LAW NO. 1-2025

WHEREAS, notice was given that the Village Board scheduled a public hearing for January 7, 2025 at 7:30 p.m. for Local Law No. 1 of the year 2025 entitled "A LOCAL LAW AMENDING CHAPTER 118 OF THE VILLAGE CODE ENTITLED 'BUILDINGS, UNSAFE'"; and

WHEREAS, notice of said public hearing was duly advertised in the official newspaper of the Village and posted on the Village Clerk's sign board; and

WHEREAS, said public hearing was duly held on the 7th day of January, 2025 at 7:30 p.m. and all parties in attendance were permitted an opportunity to speak on behalf of or in opposition to said proposed Local Law, or any part thereof; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"), it has been determined by the Village Board that adoption of the proposed Local Law constitutes a Type II Action as defined under 6 NYCRR 617.5 (26) and (33); and

WHEREAS, the Village Board, after due deliberation, finds it in the best interest of the Village to adopt said Local Law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Village Board hereby adopts said local law as Local Law No. 1 of 2025 entitled "A LOCAL LAW AMENDING CHAPTER 118 OF THE VILLAGE CODE ENTITLED 'BUILDINGS, UNSAFE'", a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Village Clerk be and hereby is directed to enter said Local Law in the minutes of this meeting and to give due notice of the adoption of said Local Law to the Secretary of State; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution will take effect immediately upon filing with the Department of State.

Resolution 10 of 2025

RESOLUTION SETTING PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING 145 HARRY L DRIVE

WHEREAS, by correspondence dated December 31, 2024, the Village Code Enforcement Officer and the Fire Marshall have requested that the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Johnson City consider declaring the building at 145 Harry L Drive, Johnson City, New York (TM# 143.41-4-4), unsafe and dangerous pursuant to Section 118-3 of the Village Code, which consideration requires a public hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Village Board will hold a public hearing on February 18, 2025, at 7:30 p.m. to solicit public input on the issue concerning whether the building at 145 Harry L Drive, Johnson City, New York should be declared unsafe and dangerous; and be it further

RESOLVED that notice of said public hearing shall be served on the record owner of 145 Harry L Drive, Johnson City, New York and its legal counsel, if known, pursuant to Section 118-6 of the Village Code; and be it further

RESOLVED that the Village Clerk and Legal Counsel are hereby authorized to take such additional and further action as is necessary to notice the public hearing as noted herein; and be it further

RESOLVED that in accordance with Section 118-9 of the Village Code, a clear and imminent danger to life, safety and health exists for persons and property, and as such the building at 145 Harry L Drive, Johnson City, New York must be secured immediately. The Village Board hereby authorizes the Code Enforcement Officer to immediately cause the securing of this building.
